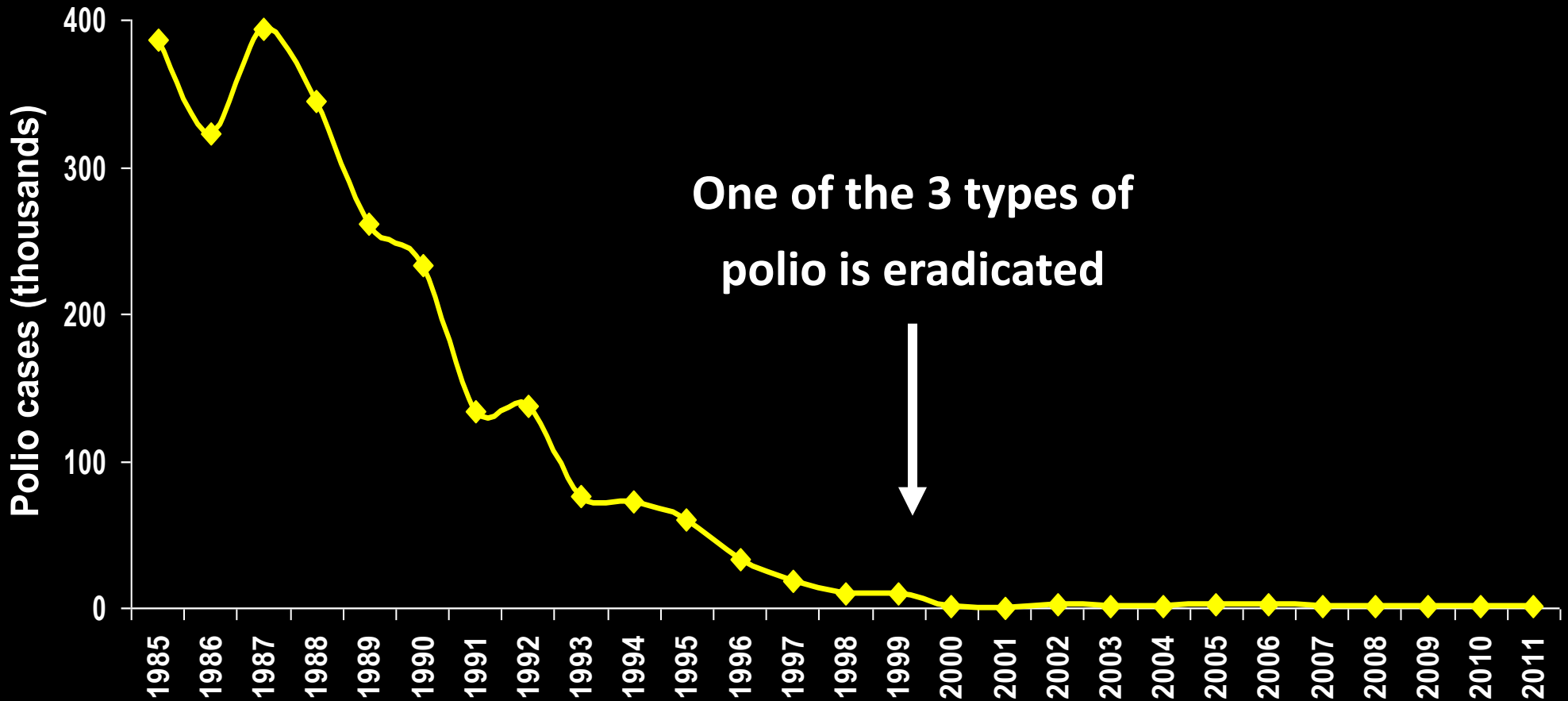

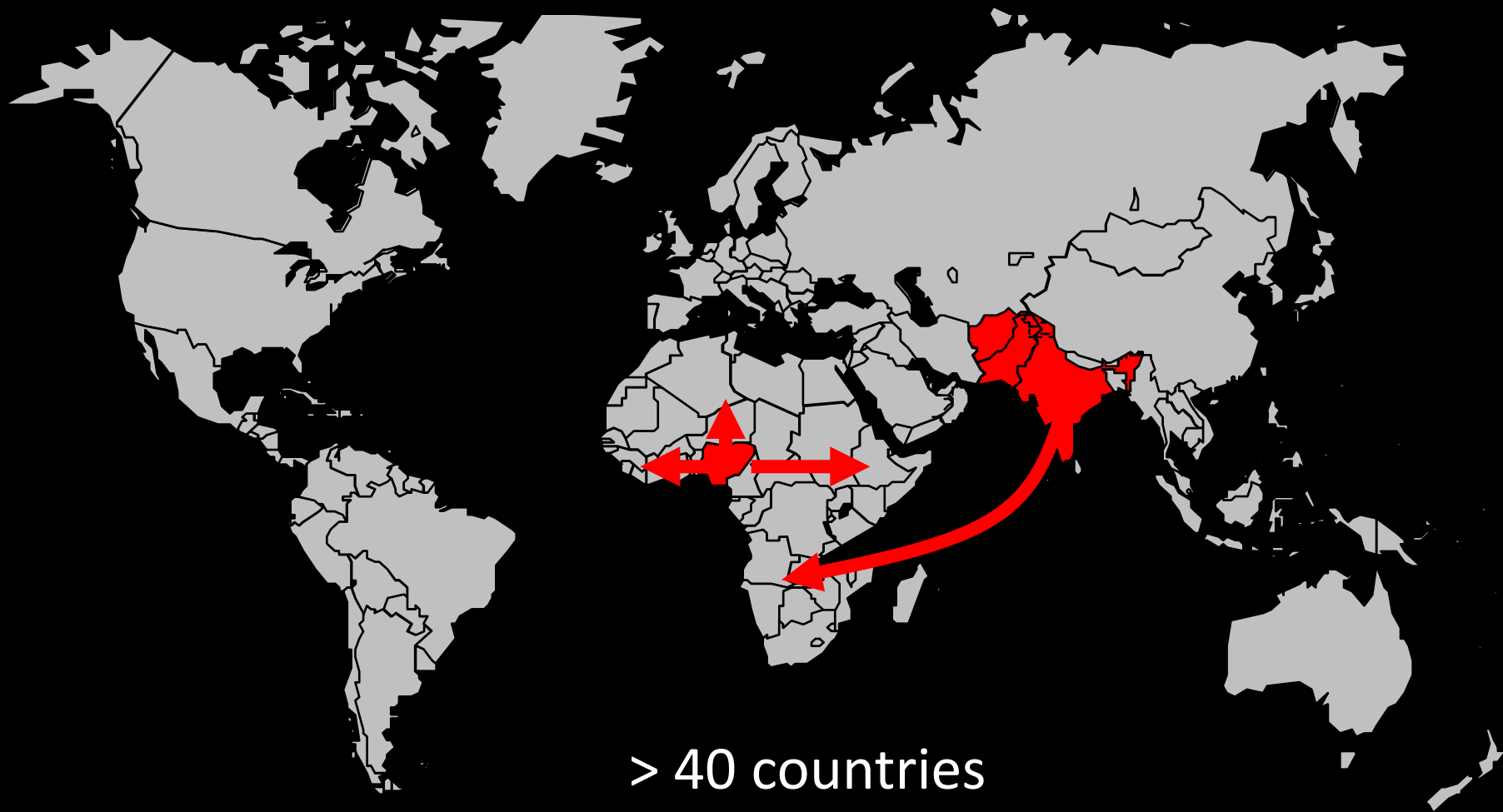

Polio-paralyzed Children, 1988-2011



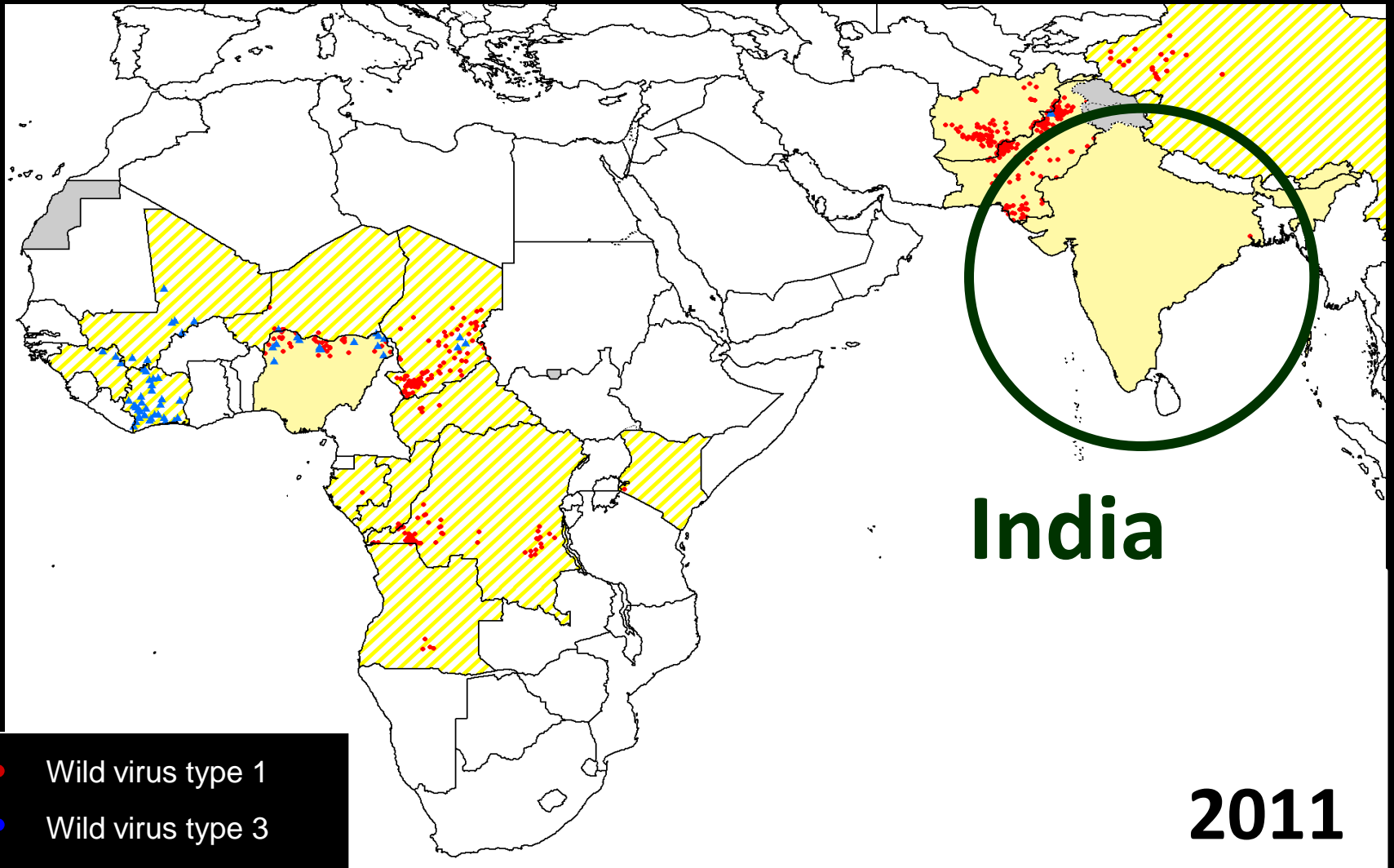
Polio Progress: 1988-2011

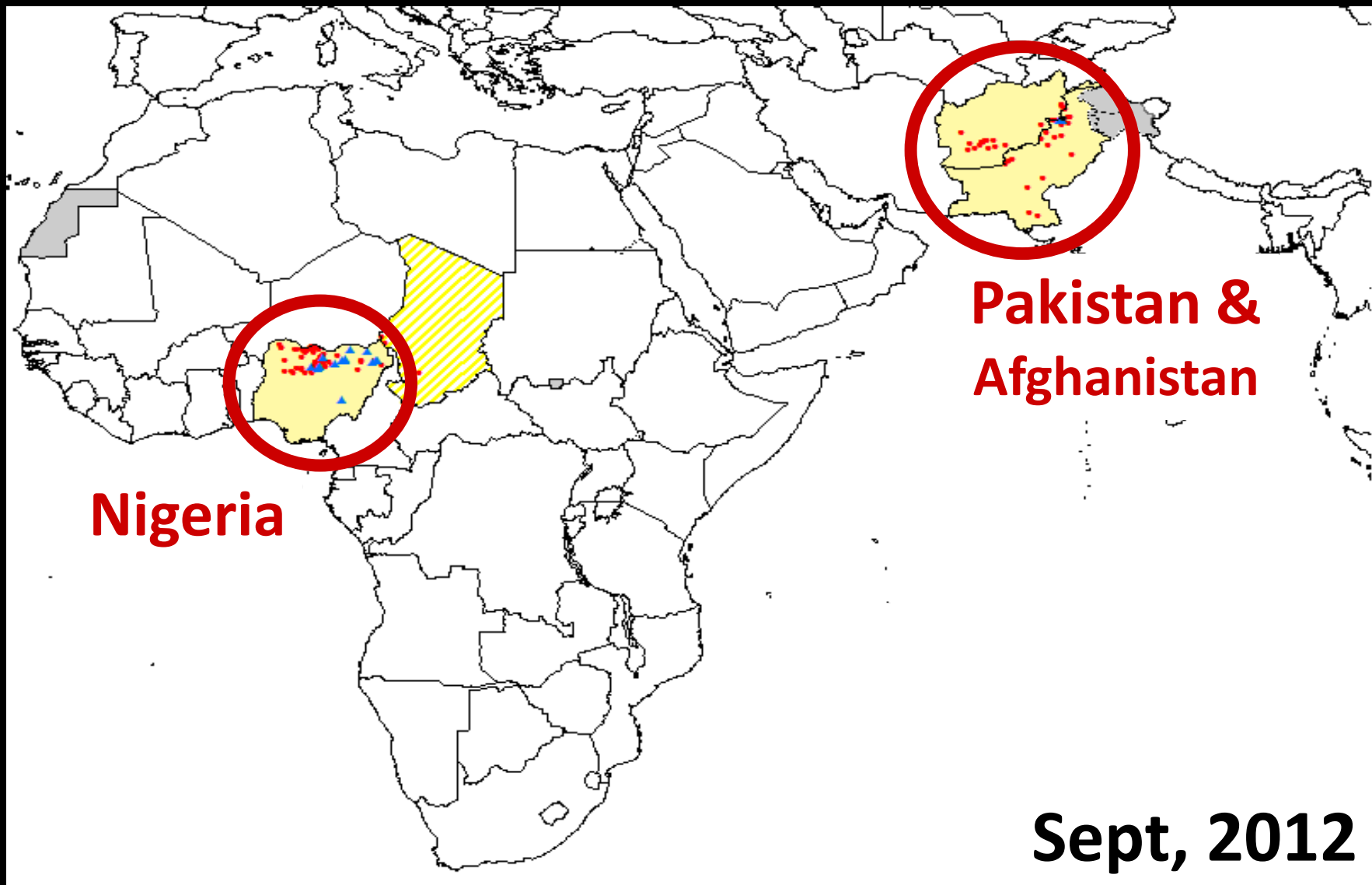

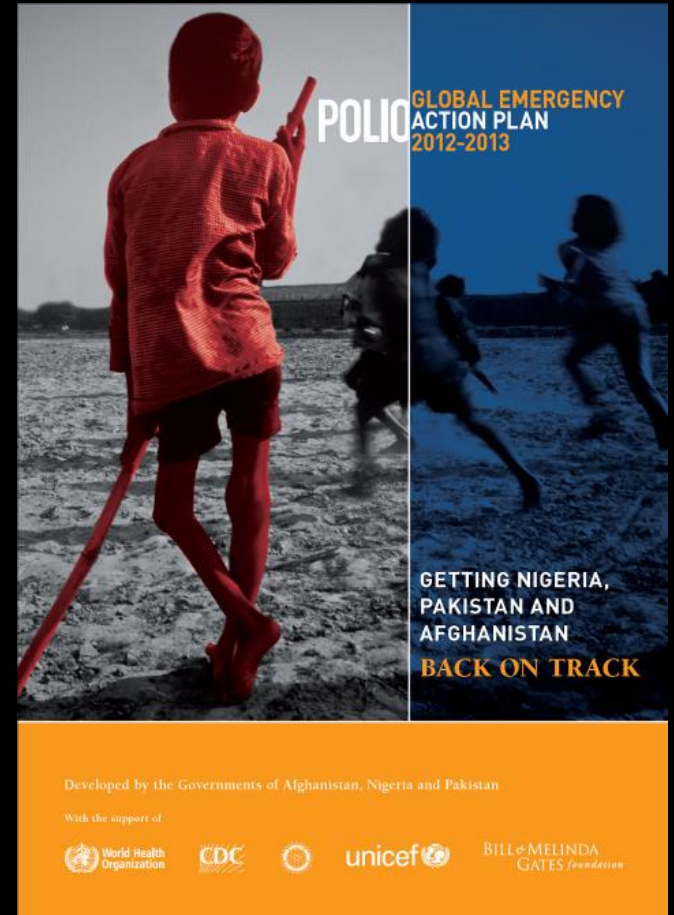

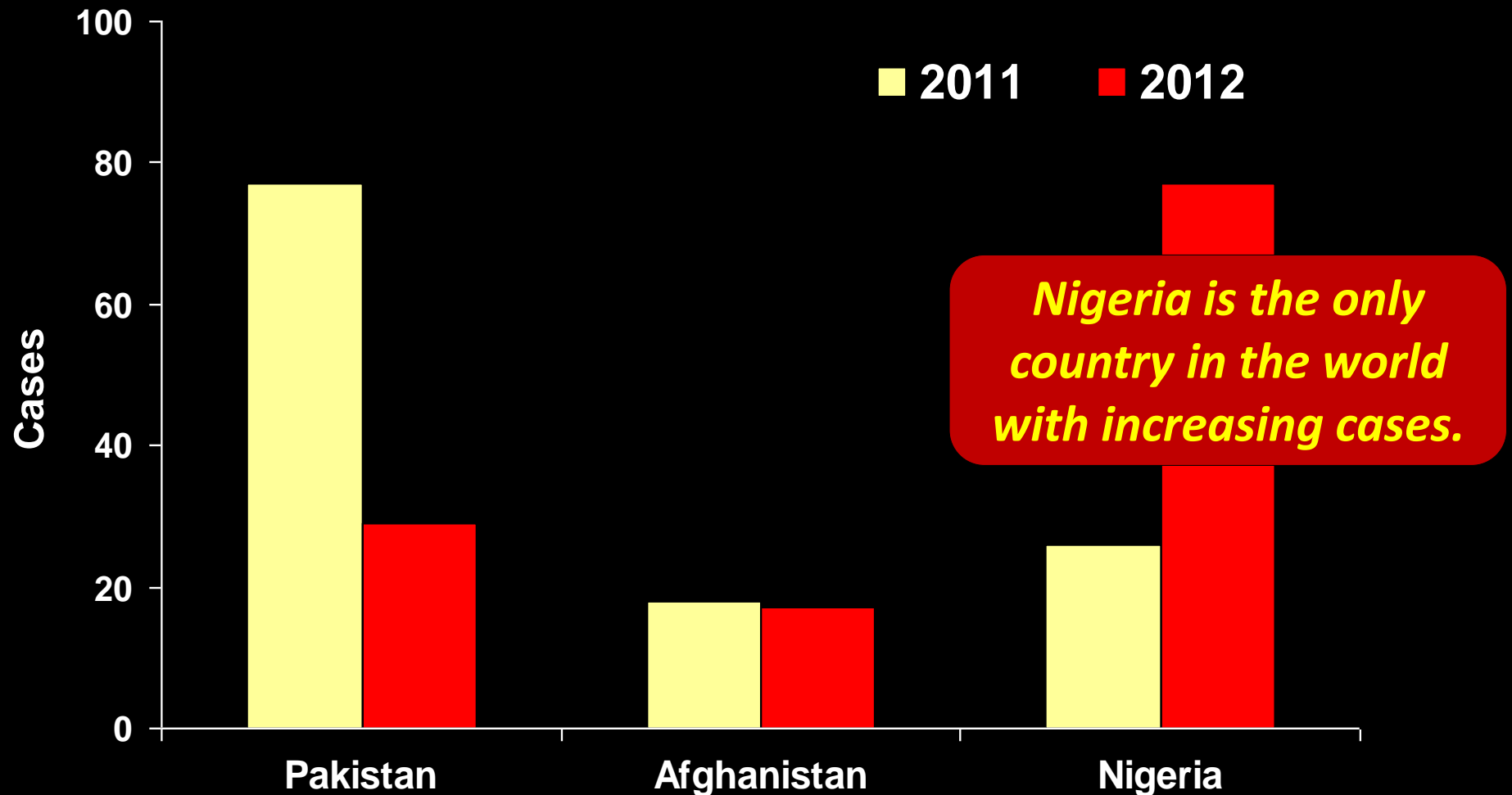


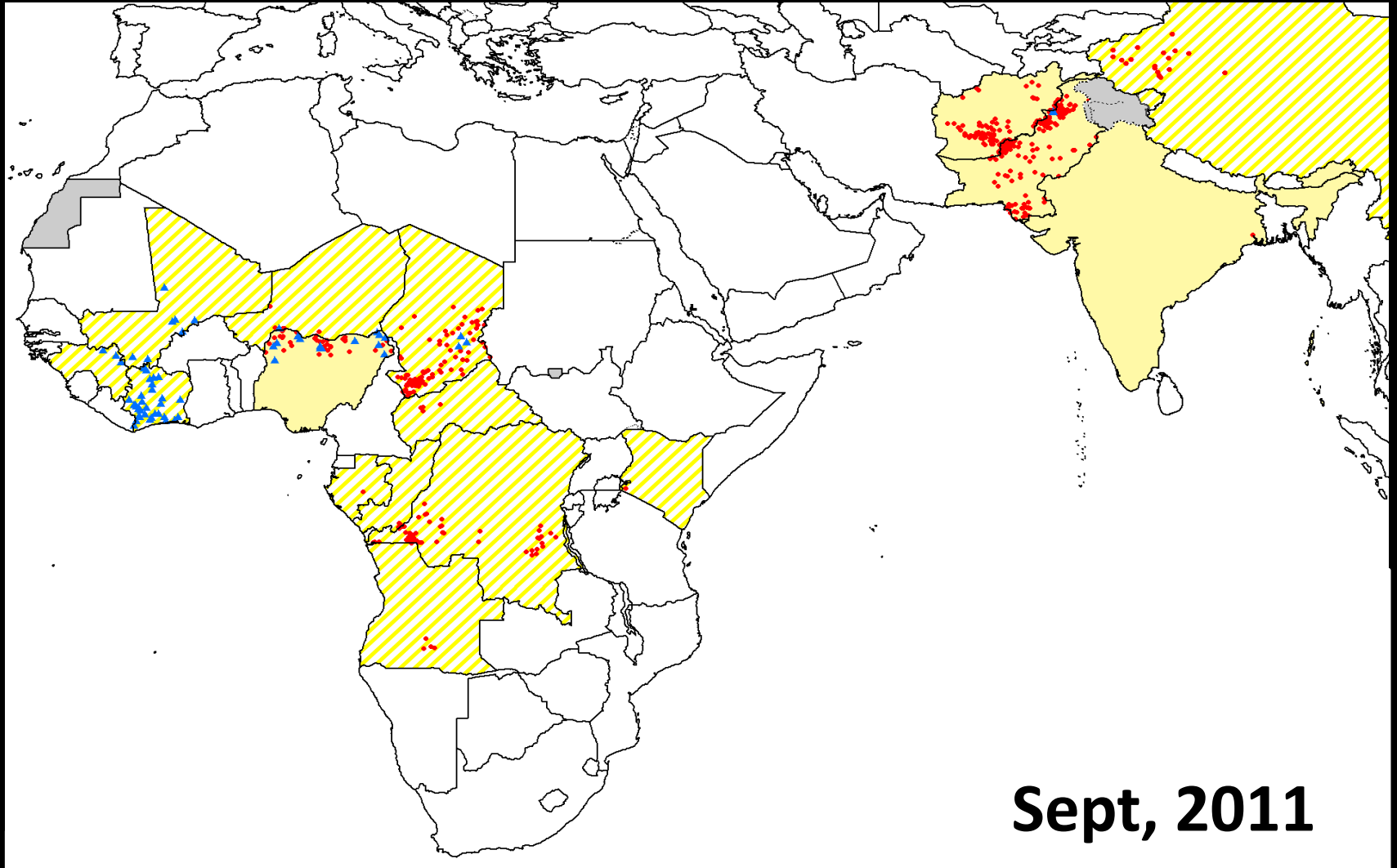
